‘**Neither do I.**’

Collocations : eg ‘**to take sth/sb at face-value**’
‘**to take sth seriously**’

Indirect Questions : eg ‘**Could you tell me where the post-office is?**’
‘**I don’t know how many children she has got.**’

We enjoy going to cafes. (verb +ing)

I look forward to hearing from you. (verb + preposition +ing)

We succeeded in passing the test. (verb + preposition +ing)

Adjective Patterns

I'm quite good at science. (good + at)

She's keen on dancing. (keen + on)

Are you afraid of spiders? (afraid + of)

give up, go out with, get on with, go for, stand up to, go off
