

10. Slovakia - Population

2010: 5,433,385 inhabitants.

Natural movement (births and deaths)

1950s = higher birth rate than death rate

2001 = higher death rate than birth rate

Justify the radical change in population's natural movements.

The *highest natural increase* has traditionally been known in districts of the:

- Prešovský self-governing region (PO, SL, BJ, KK)
- Žilinský s.g. region (NO, TS)
- Košický s.g. region (TV, MI)

The *lowest natural increase* (decrease) is typical for districts of the:

- Nitriansky s.g. region (NR, LV)
- Bratislavský s.g. region

Age structure

Life expectancy = 73 years (77 women / 69 men)

Pre-productive age (0-14) – 19%

Productive age (15 – 62) – 62%

Post-productive age (63+) – 19%

The average age (median) of Slovak population is about 34 years.

People move from countryside to larger towns for:

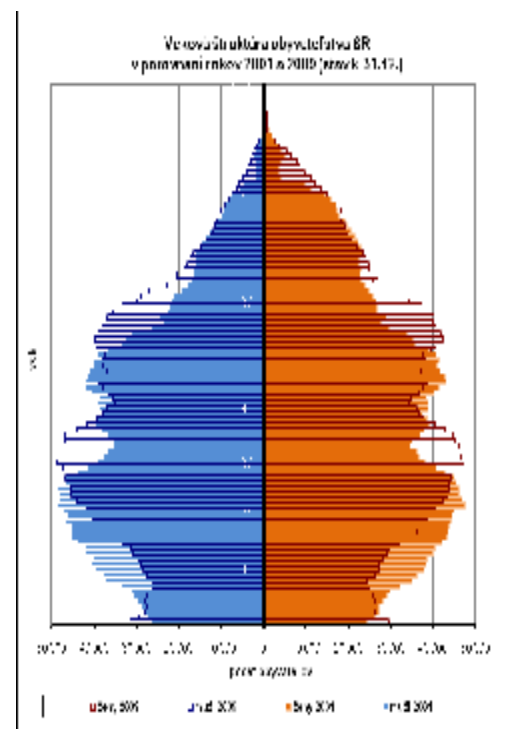
We can recognize movements into a: *district, region or other country*

Population density

§ depends on natural and mechanical movements.

§ the average population density: 110 inh./km²

§ there is unequal distribution of population *Why?*

Unemployment

The average unemployment rate: 12% (2010)

The *highest* unemployment rate:

▼ self-governing regions like BB, PO and KE.

▼ districts like RS, RA, VK

The *lowest* unemployment rate:

▼ self-governing regions like BA, TN, TT

▼ district like BA, SC, TT

Share of the economically active population (workforce) = 49%

Industry employs labour a lot but workforce in the tertiary becomes increasingly important.

Romany: 1.7 % (RO)

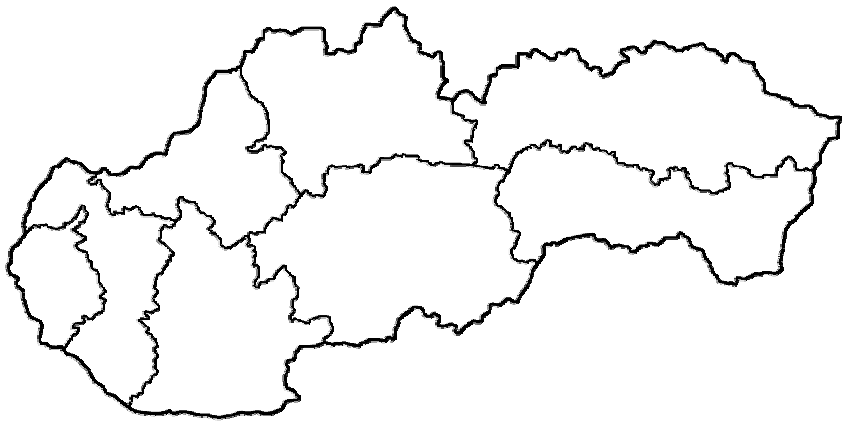
Czech: 0.8 % (C)

Locate the distribution on the map!

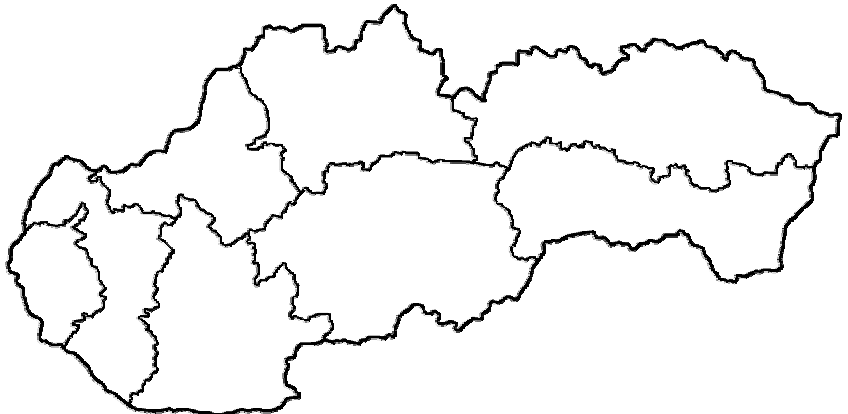
Roman-Catholics: 69 % (RC)
