## 13. Biogenic and anthropogenic landforms

## **Biogenic processes**

Plants and animals are other factors influencing the Earth's relief.

Their activities = biogenic processes = create smaller forms:

- *moorlands* (moors)
- termite mounds
- burrows
- coral reefs
- coral islands









## **Anthropogenic processes**

Man and his activities – <u>anthropogenic processes</u> – contribute to relief formation:

- quarries and mines
- roads
- settlements and their ruins
- river and sea canals

## People and their activities:

- > speed up weathering by pollutants releasing into the atmosphere
- > cause soil erosion and silting-up of dams by deforestation
- > activate artificial earthquakes, etc.



biogenic/anthropogenic processes, moor, termite mound, burrow, coral reef/island, quarry, canal, pollutants, silt-up a dam
